**RESOLUTION**

Government is pleased to decide that ceiling on the maximum amount of Retirement Gratuity and Death Gratuity should be raised from Rs. 2.50 lakhs to Rs. 3.50 lakhs with effect from 1st June 2007.


2. Government is also pleased to direct that above decision should, *mutatis mutandis*, apply to those employees of recognised and aided Educational Institutions, Non-Agricultural Universities and affiliated Non-Government Colleges and Agricultural Universities to whom the pension scheme (Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982) is made applicable.

3. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Section 243 of the Maharashtra Zilla Parishads and Panchayat Samities Act, 1961 (Mah. A. P. 1961) and of all the other powers enabling it in that behalf, Government is further pleased to decide that the above decision apply to the pensioners of Zilla Parishads.

4. Formal amendment to Rule 111 of the Maharashtra Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1982 will be made in due course.
